You can use the loader to level the ground before placing the blocks. This speeds up the construction phase, allowing you to get your site listed on Airbnb or Hipcamp sooner.

Glamping means real beds, heavy rugs, and wood-burning stoves. A cast-iron stove is incredibly heavy. Dragging it through the grass on a dolly is a nightmare.

If your site is off-grid, you may need to haul water for an outdoor shower or kitchenette. You also need to remove waste daily.

The loader can carry fresh water tanks to the site and haul grey water or rubbish away. This daily servicing is crucial for high-end hospitality. The tractor makes it a quick, easy loop, ensuring the site remains sanitary and stocked without much physical effort.
